Gakino'amaage: Teach For Canada is recruiting teachers for full-time classroom positions in First Nations in northern Ontario, Manitoba, Alberta, and Saskatchewan. Successful candidates will start teaching in September 2025.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Certified or certification-eligible to teach in a Canadian province or territory
- Legal working status in Canada for the minimum two-year teaching commitment
- Available to attend the Summer Enrichment Program July 2025
- Able to relocate and teach full-time in a rural First Nations community

WHY WE EXIST

Education in Canada is a success story, but high overall quality masks deep inequality. The right kind of teacher can work alongside northern First Nations community members to make education more equal in Canada.

As an organization that works with Indigenous communities, we value Indigenous perspectives in our program and encourage Indigenous candidates to apply. **We strive to make our application accessible for all teacher applicants by offering travel reimbursements, childcare, phone interviews, and other supports.**

2025 SELECTION PROCESS

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis and you will hear back within two weeks of submission.

The first deadline to apply is December 29th, 2024.
